Globalism shifted into high gear in 2001 when China was invited

into the World Trade Organization and corporations fled there

seeking cheap labor and materials. With the globalists' help,

China rose from \$1.2 T (trillion) to \$18.4 T today, largely at the

Expense of the United States and its manufacturing.

WHY IS THIS BROCHURE IMPORTANT?

President Trump needs help. He wants to rebalance the world where it works again as a community of nations, not a collection of serf territories, controlled by a central gov't and financial system. Most U.S. institutions are opposed to the Trump plan because they want the latter. Globalists and the CCP oppose:

- Reducing non-tariff barriers against the U.S. which grew from 600 NTBs to 2,000 in the past 25 years
- Deportations. Presidents Obama, Clinton, Bush deported 28 million with no injunctions; Trump can't deport violent criminals without multiple injunctions
- The courts rule that Biden could allow 10 million illegals to invade the U.S., but Trump can't move them out

HOW GLOBALISTS AND THE CCP DIFFER

Globalists want a central government and global financial system they control.

The Chinese Communist Party (CCP) wants to control the world government and financial system under their terms, policies and institutions.

Globalists believe Chinese communism is the only way to achieve global governance, make people depend solely on government and provide cheap labor to extend their wealth. The CCP plays along because globalists for nearly 40 years have allowed the CCP to pursue their worldwide ambitions.

But as U.S. productive capacity shrinks and Americans' purchasing power drops, the government can't bail out the economy. This spending is *not productive* because for every dollar Congress spends, it must first be taxed or borrowed from consumers or the private sector.

So gov't spending has resulted in \$37 trillion debt and Congress is incapable of cutting any of it even when there is waste, fraud and abuse. To reverse this situation, Trump must reset the global order by leveling the trade landscape, reshoring manufacturing, securing U.S. borders and play regional, not global cop.
